

## Homes & Castles

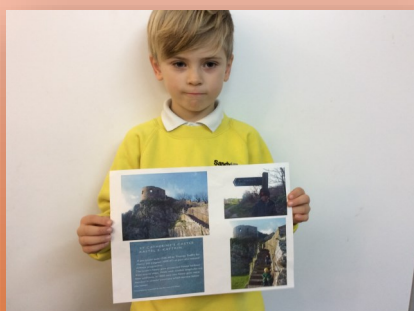

## **\*\*Important—Cross Country Date Change\*\***

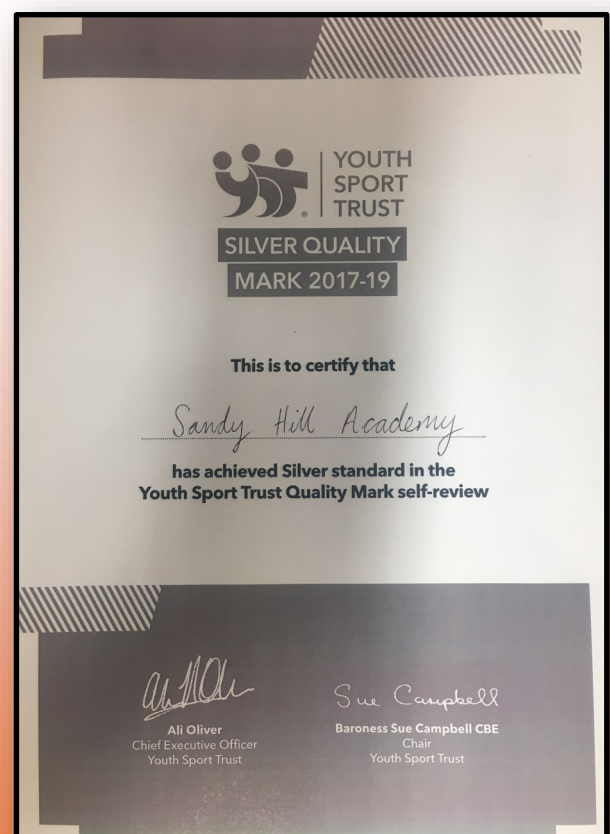
Please note that the date for the next cross country event has moved from the 7th February to the 21st February.

**Car Parking**

We appreciate that parking when dropping off and picking up your child can be difficult at times. Please be aware that the physiotherapy centre across the road is private land and not for school parking. We have received complaints from some residents around the Brookside area where driveways and turning bays have been blocked. Please do be considerate when parking. Please do not park on the pavements.
