Health Advice - Measles

The NHS has advised an increase in the number of case of measles reported in England and has issued the following letter with advice and guidance relating to measles and the MMR vaccine.

ere is currently a large ongoing outbreak of meastes in Europe and an increase in cas oughout. England. From 1 January to 9 May 2018 there have been 440 laborat infirmed meastes cases, with London (164), the Wett Midlands (78), South East (8 with West (42) and West Yorkshire (37) reporting the most cases. The South Wneates cases have centred around firstol, North Sommerset, and South Gloussetserhies

This means that unimmunised individuals will be at a real increased risk of contracting the

In order to be fully protected against measles, individuals require two doses of MMF

Symptoms of measle

up to three weeks. These can include:

- Cold-like symptoms, such as a runny nose, sneezing, and a cough

- Sore, red eyes that may be sensitive to light (conjunctivitis)

- High temperature (fever), which may reach around 40°C (104°F)

A few days later, a red-brown blotchy rash will appear. This usually starts on the head o upper neck, before spreading outwards to the rest of the body.

You should contact your GP as soon as possible if you suspect that your child may haw

In addition, if your child develops any symptoms that could be measles and is planning to travel nationable by plane, then please contact the Public Health England Health
