This weeks word of the week is "chewing" and the pseudo word is "figher".

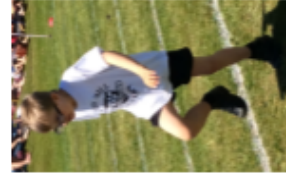
