

Here at Sandy Hill we use <u>eSchools</u> to send messages to parents in the event of the school being closed, cancelled sporting events, book parent evenings and send letters home.

The eSchools App is available on both <u>Apple</u> and <u>Android</u>, and will enable you to receive a notification direct to your mobile phone without the need for logging into the <u>eSchools web-</u> <u>site</u>.

We are also investigating using the eSchools platform more widely, for things such as reporting absence from school.

We are encouraging all parents and carers to install the eSchools app and to please make sure we have correct contact details for you.
