The Summer Reading Challenge website helps you keep track of your reading all year round: find **new books to read**, take part in **competitions** and play **games**.

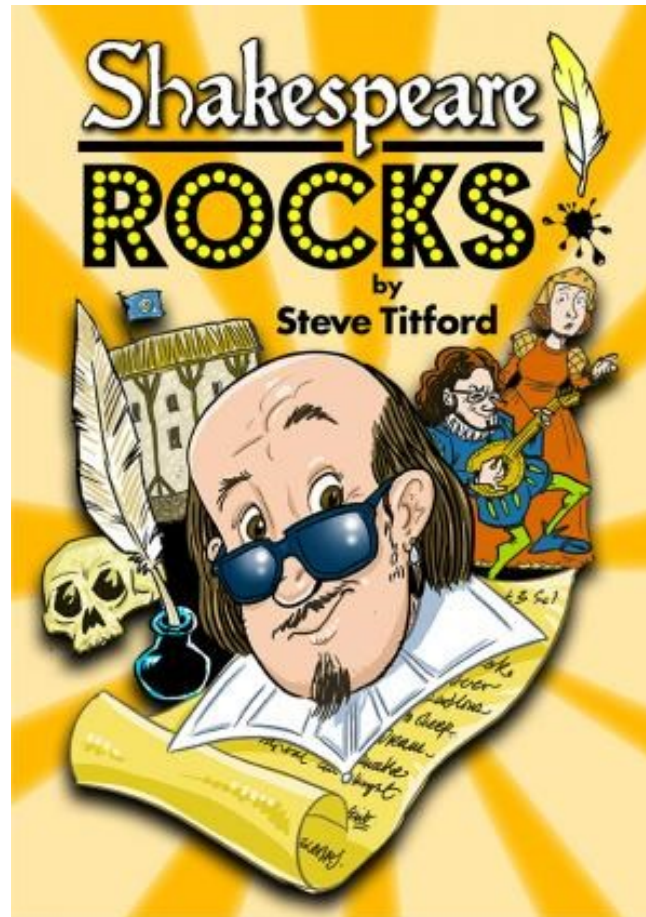

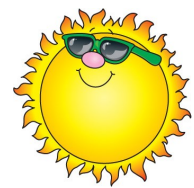
