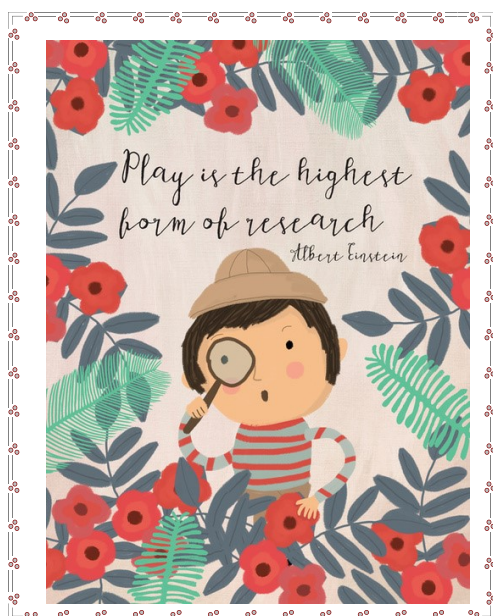
Coffee morning- 14.03.19
