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Sandy Hill Park Planned Improvements



Dear Resident

I am delighted to have secured funding from Cornwall Council to deliver new play equipment and natural play features at Sandy Hill Park. The Friends Of Sandy Hill Park, to whom I am very grateful, led a public consultation some time ago and the current proposals try to take account of that. The new play equipment includes wooden seats and a mini beast hotel which the Friends Group has donated.

It has taken a long time to turn this project into a reality but it is Cornwall Council's intention to install the play equipment in the spring so that children can start to enjoy it when better weather returns. First, however, as local Cornwall Councillor I want to hear any views you have and try to answer any questions.

In this leaflet you can see pictures of the items of play equipment and natural play features which are proposed (pictures are from other play areas and are only illustrative). 
