

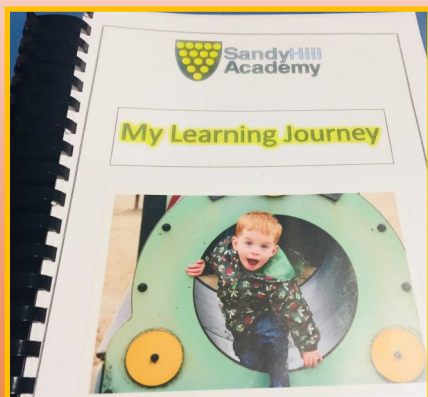
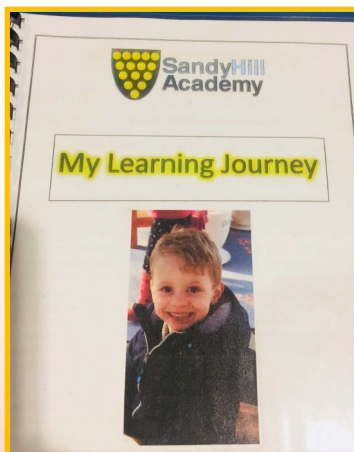

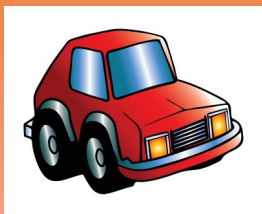

Parking



We appreciate that parking when dropping off and picking up your child can be difficult at times. Please be aware that the physiotherapy centre across the road is private land and not for school parking. We have received complaints from some residents around the Brookside area where driveways and turning bays have been blocked. Please do be considerate when parking.

Please do not park on the pavements.

Our car park is for staff and blue badge holders only and this applies at ANY time of the day. The safety of children and parents/carers within the car park is paramount.

We encourage children to walk, cycle and scooter where possible. Each child who participates in walking, cycling or scootering **and wears a helmet** to and from school will earn merit points.
