Cornwall & Scilly Maths Contest

Sumdog's Cornwall & Scilly Maths Contest is here! It started yesterday at 8am, and finishes at 8pm on December 13.

Here are some things to keep in mind during the contest:

- Students can play at any time.
- For the score to count, the Cornwall & Scilly Maths Contest activity must be showing in the green panel on the left of the student's screen when they click to start each game.
- Their scores are based on correct answers.
- A class's score is the average of the scores from all students from that class who take part.
- To appear on the leader board, at least 10 students from a class need to play.
- As some students have a limited computer access, every student is limited to 1000 contest questions. However, their free logins let them keep playing other activities afterwards.
- Students who are added (or removed) from a class after the contest has started will not be added (or removed) from the contest. You can still add entire classes to the contest after the start date however.
