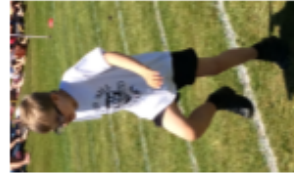
Readathon Update

Sports day will start at 1:00pm.

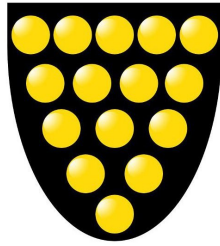
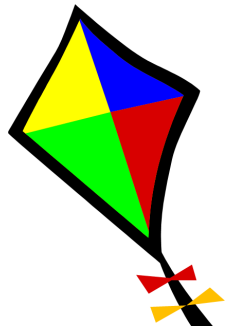
If you would like to come and watch Sports Day the top gate will open at 12.45pm.

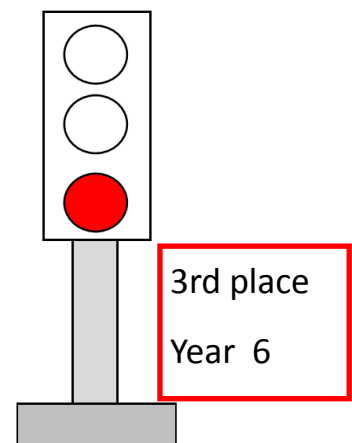
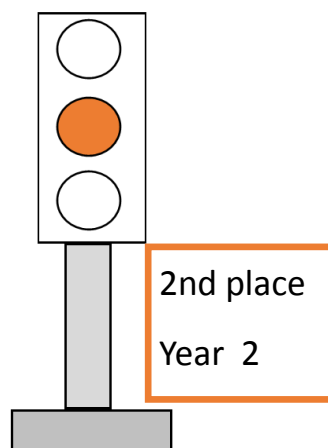
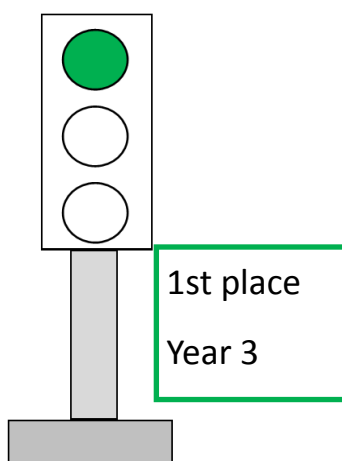
