Spring 1 Topic: People Who Help Us / Dinosaurs

Literacy/Communication and Language	Practise name writing. Read a chosen library book from our Early Years Library every evening at home. With your child's weekly library book discuss the characters in the story and how they might be feeling.		
Mathematics	Reciting numbers past 5 and linking numerals to amounts. Can you learn how to describe your route around your garden or to Nursery using positional language.		
Expressive Arts and Design	<u>Build your own small-world</u> Can you have a go at building your own small-world? This could be a den or habitat for dinosaurs!	<u>Dance to music with rhythm</u> Can you have a go at dancing to music with rhythm?	<u>Using scissors and glue</u> Can you practise using scissors and glue to create models at home?
Understanding of the World	<u>Learning about different jobs</u> Can you have a think about what job you would like to do when you grow up and why?	<u>Chinese New Year</u> Can you learn a simple fact about Chinese New Year?	<u>Similarities and differences</u> Can you find out different similarities/differences in your family e.g. "Me and my Mummy both have brown eyes!"
Physical Development	<u>Preparing for puddles!</u> Can you practise putting on your coat and wellies all by yourself to prepare for puddles?	<u>Cosmic Yoga: Tiny the T-Rex!</u> Can you have a go at doing some cosmic Yoga?
