Mathematics	Counting up to 20/ Counting back from 10/ Counting objects to 10 and beyond.		
Expressive Arts and Design	<u>Learn a simple song</u> Can you learn a simple song to teach a school friend?	<u>Self-portrait</u> Can you draw a picture of yourself– use a mirror to notice details like your eye colour, freckles etc.	<u>Make up a story..</u> Can you make up a story using some of your toys? once upon a time...
Understanding the World	<u>Weather Record</u> Children to create a simple record about the daily weather– noticing seasonal changes.	<u>Make a Map</u> Can you draw your house on your road– what other features can you add to your map?	Describe what they see, hear and feel outside– can you name any plants or animals that you see?
Physical Development	<u>Using Tools</u> Can you use a knife and fork to cut up your own food? (Don’t forget to use your manners at meal times)	<u>Ball Skills</u> Can you roll a ball to a friend? Can you throw a ball to a friend? Can you catch a ball with two hands?	<u>Obstacle Course</u> Can you create an obstacle course to combine different movements where you have to: run, hop, crawl, climb and jump?
