HSE COVID Inspection

On Friday 6th November, a HSE COVID Secure Inspection was carried out in school by a local HM Inspector of Health & Safety on behalf of the Health & Safety Executive.

The Health & Safety Executive are undertaking these spot check visits nationally, to ensure COVID-19 risks are being controlled in line with Public Health and Department for Education guidance in schools, focussing on the school's COVID controls to ensure a safe environment for our children at school at this challenging time.

The inspector was shown around the whole school, not entering any class bubbles, reviewing our policies and observing practical procedures that we have in place. He had access to all our risk assessments, protocols and procedures across the entire academy.
